

Questions About Participating in an Environmental Education Program?

Frequently Given Answers (to Frequently Asked Questions)

Clothing:

Above all, dress appropriately for the weather. Unless the weather is severe, there is no bad weather, only bad clothing! The program is very hands-on, so please do not wear nice clothes, they will get dirty! Dress in layers. The weather may fluctuate, and so will your body temperature. Bring a shell/windbreaker/rain coat just in case.

- Shoes: Wear a good, sturdy shoe or boot. Tennis shoes/running shoes/sneakers will work. *We do not allow open-toed shoes or sandals.*
- Pants/shorts: Pants or jeans that are flexible and won't rip or tear are a great choice. Shorts are great in heat.
- Jewelry: We ask participants to remove anything that dangles or might get caught. Leave valuables at home.

Weather:

See above on clothing. Unless the weather is severe, we will be outside. Experiences aren't canceled because of rain; they just get to be more fun (if you are dressed appropriately). In the event of severe weather, we'll work with your group coordinator to make alternative plans.

Safety:

Your physical and emotional safety is our primary concern. Consequently, our facilitators have been trained in the standards and procedures that make this program safe.

Water:

It is very important that participants bring a filled water bottle with them. We encourage participants to stay hydrated.
