Back in the woods on the top of a hill, a space is being cleared for our new Education Building. The area has been surveyed, utilities have been marked and the bid process is coming to a close. When completed a year from now, LAC's new Education Building will allow our current programs to expand into the winter months as well as to introduce new possibilities for education in our area. The building will feature more than 6,500 square feet of education space, two levels, an energy-efficient HVAC system and a large wood-burning fireplace. The building will also include a 12'x 60' porch for watching wildlife, enjoying the wooded scenery and relaxing to the sounds of nature. It will truly be a spectacular building and we look forward to opening the doors next year!
